How to change Voice of some typical Sentences

Note:

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We will talk about some typical sentences which do change their voice but they don't have any particular rule. So, we can just look at all these examples and can frame an idea, that how we can change their voice.

Examples:

1. I have a torch. A torch is had by me.

2. We saw her go out. She was seen to go out.

Hate none.
None should be hated.
Or
Let no one be hated.

4. We believed what we said.What was said by us was believed by us.

5. God helps those who help themselves. Those who help themselves are helped by God.

In all these sentences we can clearly see that no general pattern is followed. The only similarity we can see is the third form of the verb and use of the word 'by'.
