Future perfect tense (answer positive)	
मैं कल पिकनिक जा चुका होगा	I will have gone to picnic
वह मुझे फ़ोन कर चुका होगा	He will have called me
वह कार चला चुकी होगी	She will have driven car.
वे (लोग) फुटबॉल खेल चुके होंगे	They will have played football.
Future perfect (answer negative)	
मैं पिकनिक नहीं जा चुका होगा	I will not have gone to picnic
वह कार नहीं चला चुकी होगी	She will not have driven car.
वह मुझे फ़ोन नहीं कर चुका होगा	He will not have called me
वे (लोग) फुटबॉल नहीं खेल चुके होंगे	They will not have played football.
ट्रेन समय पर नहीं आ चुकी होगी	The train will not have arrived on time.
future perfect tense (Questions)	
क्या तुम पिकनिक जा चुके होंगे	Will you have gone to picnic?
क्या वह कार चला चुकी होगी	Will she have driven car?
क्या वह तुम्हें फ़ोन कर चुका होगा	Will he have called you?
क्या वे (लोग) फुटबॉल खेल चुके होंगे	Will they have played football?

उदाहरण : Question in (Future perfect continuous tense)

future perfect continuous (answer positive)	
में दो घंटे से यात्रा कर रहा होगा	I will have been travelling for two hours.
वह सुबह से कार चला रही होगी	She will have been driving car since Morning.
वह मुझे दो घंटे से फ़ोन कर रहा होगा	He will have been calling me for 2 hours.
वे (लोग) सुबह से फुटबॉल खेल रहे होंगे	They will have been playing football since Morning.
हम दोपहर से एग्जाम दे रहे होंगे	We will have been facing exam since afternoon.
Future perfect Continuous (Answer Negative)	
में दो घंटे से यात्रा नहीं कर रहा होगा	I will not have been travelling for 2 hours.
वह सुबह से कार नहीं चला रहा होगा	He will not have been driving car since Morning.
वह दो घंटे से खाना नहीं बना रही होगी	She will not have been cooking food for 2 hours.
राम सुबह से नहीं खेल रहा होगा	Ram will not have been playing since Morning.
बारिश सोमवार से नहीं हो रही होगी	It will not have been raining since Monday.
future continuous(question)	
क्या तुम दो घंटे से यात्रा कर रहे होंगे	Will you have been travelling for 2 hours?
क्या वह 30 मिनट से कार चला रहा होगा	Will he have been driving car for 30 minutes?
क्या गीता शाम से टीवी देख रही होगी	Will Geeta have been watching TV since Evening?

Some Common dialogues for daily use:

1. A Piece of Cake – बहुत आसान बात या कार्य
2. Do as romans do – जैसा देश वैसा भेश
3. Nearer the church farther from heaven – चिराग तले अँधेरा
