Some daily usages phrase with example:

Past simple tense (answer positive)	
राम ने मेरी किताब चुराई।	Ram stole my book.
तुम स्कूल गये थे।	You went to school.
रमेश बाजार गये थे	Ramesh went to market.
मोहन आम खरीदा	Mohan bought mango.
राकेश काम किया।	Rakesh worked.
Past simple (answer negative)	
राम ने मेरी किताब नहीं चुराई।	Ram did not steal my book.
तुम स्कूल नहीं गये थे।	You did not go to school.
मीना ने एक मधुर गीत नहीं गाया।	Meena did not sing a melodious song.
राकेश काम नहीं किया	Rakesh did not work.
मोहन आम नहीं खरीदा	Mohan did not buy mango.
Past simple tense (Questions)	
क्या मीना ने एक मधुर गीत गाया	Did Meena sing a melodious song?
क्या राकेश काम नहीं किया	Did Rakesh not work?
क्या मोहन आम खरीदा	Did Mohan buy mango?

उदाहरण : Question in (past continuous tense)

Past continuous (answer positive)	
वह एक मधुर गाना गा रही थी।	She was singing a melodious song.
मैं खेल रहा था।	I was playing.
वह गाय खरीद रहा था	He was buying a cow.
हम खेल रहे थे।	We were playing
वे गाय खरीद रहे थे	They were buying a cow.
वह पढ़ रहा था।	He was reading



Past continuous (Answer Negative)	
मैं अपनी किताब नहीं पढ़ रहा था।	I was not reading my book.
वे मेरे नौकर को नहीं बुला रहे थे।	They were not calling my servant.
मैं गहरी नींद में नहीं सो रहा था।	I was not sleeping soundly.
राम दीवार से नहीं कूद रहा था।	Ram was not jumping from the wall.
मैं स्कूल नहीं जा रहा था।	I was not going to school.
Past continuous (question)	
क्या वह अपना पाठ याद कर रहा था	Was he learning his lesson?
क्या वे मेरे नौकर को बुला रहे थे	Were they calling my servant?
क्या वे लड़के शोर नहीं मचा रहे थे	Were they not making a noise?

Some Common dialogues:

1. A Figure among cyphers. – अंधों में काना राजा
2. Necessity is the mother of invention. – आवश्यकता अविष्कार की जननी है
3. As you sow, so shall you reap. – जैसा करोगे वैसा भरोगे
4. Barking dog seldom bite. – जो गरजते हैं वो बरसते नहीं
5. A drowning man catches at straw. – डूबते को तिनके का सहारा
