Some daily usages phrase with example:

Past simple tense (answer positive)	
मैं यह समाचार पहले ही सुन चुका था ।	I had already listened to that news.
वह गाना गा चुकी थी ।	She had sung song.
हमने अपने कमरे का किराया दे दिया था ।	We had given rent of our room.
बारिश हो चुकी थी ।	It had rained
डाक्टर जा चुका था	The doctor had gone
Past simple (answer negative)	
वह लडका स्कूल नहीं गया था	That boy had not gone to school
मेरा बडा भाई एम. ए. नहीं कर चुका था	My elder brother had not passed M. A
पिताजी ने यह खबर पहले नहीं पढी थी	The father had not read this news before
वर्षा आरम्भ होने से पहले लडकियाँ अपने घर नहीं गयी थीं	The girls had not gone to their home before it rained.
उसने अपना काम पहले ही पूरा नहीं किया था	He hadn't already completed his task
Past simple tense (Questions)	
क्या चोर भाग चुका था ?	Had the thief fled away
क्या उसने तुमसे बात कर ली थी	Had he talked to you ?
क्या मैंने तुम्हें सौ का नोट दिया था ?	Had I given you a hundred rupee note

उदाहरण : Question in (past continuous tense)

Future Simple (answer positive)	
राम पढ़ेगा	Ram will read
तुम काम करोगे	You will work
मैं आपकी मदद करूँगा	I will help you
वह अंग्रेजी पढ़ायेगा	He will teach English
हमलोग नई दिल्ली जायेंगे	We shall go to New Delhi.
Future simple (Answer Negative)	
अब मैं उसका इन्तज़ार नहीं करूँगा	Now, I will not wait for her
लेखक पाठ नहीं लिखेगा	The writer Will not write the lesson
विद्यार्थी क्लास में शोर नहीं करेंगे	Students will not make noise in the class.
मैं यह बैग कभी नहीं उठाऊँगा	I shall never lift this bag
वे ताजमहल देखने नहीं जायेंगे	They will not go to see the Taj Mahal
Past continuous(question)	
क्या आज आपके घर महमान आयेंगे	Will the guests come to your home ?
क्या नौकर बाज़ार से सब्जी लायेगा	Will the servant bring vegetables from the market ?
क्या तुम बिजली का बिल जमा करोगे	Will you deposit electricity bill ?

Some Common dialogues:

1. Diamonds cut diamonds. – लोहा लोहे को काटता है
2. Once bitten twice shy – दूध का जल छाछ को भी फूंक – फूंक कर पीता है
3. A wolf in lamb's clothing – भेड़ की खाल में भेड़िया
4. All is well if ends well – अंत भला तो सब भला
5. All that glitters is not gold. – हर चमकने वाली चीज सोना नहीं होती
