Going to (gonna)- we use going to or gonna when we are just doing something. There are some sentences as examples:

जब हम कुछ कर करने वाले होते हैं तो हम Going to का उपयोग करते हैं। उदाहरण के तौर पर कुछ वाक्य हैं:

Formula:

Subject + is/am/are + going to + verb1 + object

I am going to make breakfast.

मैं नाश्ता बनाने जा रहा हूँ।

7	I was going to (gonna) take tea.	मैं चाय लेने जा रहा था।

Want to (wanna)- We use wanna describe desire.

Formula:

Subject + wanna+ V + Obj

I wanna drive the car.

मैं कार चलाना चाहता हूँ।

He wants to go to picnic.

वह पिकनिक जाना चाहता है

	Sentence	Hindi Meaning
Present tense	Do you wanna go?	क्या तुम जाना चाहते हो ।
Present tense	I wanna go	मैं जाना चाहता हूँ
Present tense	I do not wanna meet him	मैं उससे मिलना नहीं चाहता हूँ
Present tense	Does he wanna fight?	क्या वह लड़ना चाहता है
Present tense	He wants to fight?	वह लड़ना चाहता है
Present tense	He doesn't wanna fight	वह लड़ना नहीं चाहता है
Past tense	Did you wanna attend the party?	क्या तुम पार्टी अटेंड करना चाहते थे
Past tense	I wanted to attend the party.	मैं पार्टी अटेंड करना चाहता था



Past tense	I did not wanna attend the party.	मैं पार्टी अटेंड करना नहीं चाहता था
Past tense	Did he wanna drive car?	क्या वह कार चलाना चाहता था
Past tense	He wanted to drive car.	वह कार चलाना चाहता था
Past tense	He did not wanna drive car.	वह कार चलाना नहीं चाहता था
Future tense	Will you wanna buy fruits?	क्या तुम फ्रूट खरीदना चाहोगे
Future tense	I will wanna buy fruits.	मैं फ्रूट खरीदना चाहूंगा
Future tense	I will not wanna buy fruits.	मैं फ्रूट खरीदना नहीं चाहूंगा
