

DEFINITION:

Emphatic pronouns are compound personal pronouns such as **'himself'**, **'myself'** and **'yourself'** used for emphasis. When reflexive pronouns are used to emphasize the noun, they are called emphatic pronouns.

For example:

She <u>herself</u> informed me.

They themselves saw it.

GAP FILLING(FILL WITH EMPHATIC PRONOUNS)
I will build the house <u>myself</u>.
We will watch the show <u>ourselves</u>.
You <u>yourself</u> can tell us about the situation.
We saw the President <u>himself</u>.
She <u>herself</u> told us the news.
The city <u>itself</u> does not receive much rainfall.
They <u>themselves</u> prefer to stay at home.

Pronouns are called reflexive pronouns when the action of the verb turns back on the subject.

Reflexive pronouns are usually objects of the verb.

Eg: I fed <u>myself</u> the grapes.

You accidentally cut <u>yourself</u> last Thursday. We blame <u>ourselves</u> for the accident. Jonah helped <u>himself</u> to the food. Lisa read to <u>herself</u> in the afternoon. They bought <u>themselves</u> new shoes.



• Reflexive pronouns show that the action of the subject reflects upon the doer. However, an emphatic pronoun simply emphasizes the action of the subject.

Example:

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She cut herself. - herself is a reflexive pronoun since the subject's (the girl's) action (cutting) refers back to the doer (the girl).

She herself cut the cake. - herself is an emphatic pronoun because it is emphasizing the subject (the girl)

• He cut himself. (Reflexive: here the subject and object refer to the same person.)

He himself cut the cake. (Emphatic: here the emphatic pronoun himself merely puts emphasis on the noun he.) I spoke to the principal myself. (Emphatic) You must blame yourself for the loss. (Reflexive)

Note that an emphatic pronoun can be removed from the sentence and the core meaning would not be affected. A reflexive pronoun, on the other hand, is indispensable. The sentence wouldn't make complete sense if you remove the reflexive pronoun.

Compare: He himself cut the cake. He cut the cake. He cut himself. He cut ...what?

You will have noticed that in the first pair of sentences, the core meaning doesn't change when the emphatic pronoun himself is removed from the sentence. In the second pair of sentences, the meaning changes or becomes incomplete when the reflexive pronoun is removed.

TRICK TO FIND OUT REFLEXIVE AND EMPHATIC PRONOUN

If you have trouble finding out whether a pronoun is emphatic or reflexive try this simple trick. Just remove the pronoun from the sentence. If it still makes sense, the pronoun was emphatic. If it doesn't, it was reflexive.Study the following examples.

He killed **himself**.Remove the pronoun himself and you will get 'He killed'. Does it make complete sense? No, it doesn't. So, the pronoun was reflexive. A reflexive pronoun acts as the object of a transitive verb. If you remove it, some meaning will be lost.

Now consider another example.



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Sophie **herself** told me that she was going abroad.Remove the pronoun herself from the sentence. Does the sentence still make sense? Yes, it does.

An emphatic pronoun merely puts an emphasis on a noun or pronoun. It can be removed without causing any ungrammaticality.

MORAL STORY(find out Emphatic and reflexive pronoun)

Once there was a crow who wishes to be colorful and beautiful like other birds.He <u>himself(E)</u> thought to ask the parrot. He then went to the parrot and shared his thoughts.

But parrot said peacock is most beautiful bird so talk to him.you should go <u>yourself(R)</u> and ask her. Then the crow went to the peacock and told him about his looks.

Then the peacock replied," You are the luckiest bird that has been never caged in life and we because of our beauty stay caged, and you are always free."so you should love <u>vourself</u>.(R)

After listening to this, crow realized his mistake and thanked God for making him like this and he flew away happily.

Moral: <u>Never compare yourself to others. Be happy with what you have and</u> <u>what you are.</u>
