



#### Learning Objective:

The learning objective of this lesson as follows: In this session we will learn about reciprocal pronoun and its types

- a) Definition of Reciprocal pronoun

### **DEFINITION:**

We use reciprocal pronouns when each of two or more subjects is acting in the same way towards the other. For example, Rohan is talking to Ria, and Ria is talking to Rohan So we say:

Rohan and Ria are talking to **each other**.

The action is "reciprocated". Jay talks to Mita and Mita talks to Jay. I give you a present and you give me a present. The dog bites the cat and the cat bites the dog.

There are only two reciprocal pronouns, and they are both two words:

#### each other

#### one another

When we use these reciprocal pronouns:

- there must be **two or more** people, things or groups involved (so we cannot use reciprocal pronouns with I, you [singular], he/she/it)
- they must be doing the same thing EXERSISE
- The ten gangsters were fighting **one another**.
- The five babies were bumping against **one onother** in the bed.
- Jay and Mita love **each other**.
- Diya and Dev hate each other.
- Both teams played hard against **each other**.

MORAL STORY(improve reading skill and listening skill)

Once there was a dog who wandered the streets night and day in search of food. One day, he found a big juicy bone and he immediately grabbed it between his mouth and took it home. He met many dogs on his way they were barking at <u>one another</u>. On his way home, he crossed a river and saw another dog who also had a bone in its mouth. He wanted that bone for himself too. They started barking at <u>eachother</u>, but as he opened his mouth, the bone he was biting fell into the river and sank. That night, he went home hungry. Moral of the story:

If we always envy what others have, we'll end up losing what we already have, just like the greedy dog.
