

#### **DEFINITION:**

A pronoun is a word that replaces a noun in a sentence. Pronouns are used to avoid repeating the same nouns over and over again. ... Common pronouns include me, me, mine, her, him, it, us, and us. In truth, there are many different types of pronouns, each serving a different purpose.

#### **Demonstrative pronouns:**

Are "this," "that," "these," and "those."

#### Indefinite Pronouns:

It includes "all," "some," "any," "several," "anyone," nobody," "each," "both," "few," "either," "none," "one", and "no one,"

#### INTERROGATIVE PRONOUN:

The interrogative pronouns are "what," "which," "who," "whom," and "whose."

#### **Personal Pronouns:**

The personal pronouns are "I," "you," "he," "she," "it," "we," "they," and "who."

#### **Possessive Pronouns:**

The possessive pronouns are "mine," "yours," "his," "hers," "ours," and "theirs."

#### **Relative Pronouns:**

The relative pronouns are "which," "that," and "who" (including "whom" and "whose

#### **Reciprocal Pronouns**

The reciprocal pronouns are "each other" and "one another

#### **Reflexive Pronouns**

The reflexive pronouns are "myself," "yourself," "herself," "himself," "itself," "ourselves," "yourselves," and "themselves."

#### Intensive (or Emphatic) Pronouns

The intensive pronouns are "myself," "yourself," "herself," "himself," "itself," "ourselves," "yourselves," and "themselves." (They are the same as the reflexive pronouns, but they are used differently.)

#### **MORAL STORY**

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This is a story that explains how adversity is met differently by different people. There was a girl named Asha who lived with her mother and father in a village. One day, her father assigned her a simple task. <u>He</u> took three vessels filled with boiling water. <u>He</u> placed an egg in one vessel, a potato in the second vessel, and some tea leaves in the third vessel.
