



DEFINITION:

ADJECTIVE-words that usually provide relevant information about the nouns/pronouns they modify/describe by answering the questions: *What kind? How many? Which one? How much?* Adjectives enrich your writing by adding precision and originality to it.

Types of adjectives

- Proper An adjective that comes from a proper noun Example -Shakespearean and Christian
- Descriptive, qualitative or attributive A descriptive adjective is an objective that modifies a noun or pronoun example -tall ,small
- Quantitative -The adjective which is used to describe a noun and pronoun with quantity numbers
 Examples-cardinal or ordinals
- Demonstrative- An adjective used to describe the position of something or someone example -that these ,those
- Distributive- A distributive objective is an objective that refers to member of group individually example each ,every
- Interrogative -Interrogative adjective is that adjective that modifies a noun by asking a question example what , which, whose
- Possessive -An objective that modifies a noun by identifying who has ownership or possession of it example- your, his ,their
