#### **DEFINITION: Revision.**

#### Adjective

Noun Words that usually provide relevant information about noun and pronoun, as we have learnt there are different types of adjectives we have also learnt that adjectives are formed from noun -: boy -boyish silk- silken from verb Talk-talkative Move -movable Adjectivered -reddish sick- sickly Comparison of adjectives

There are three degrees of comparison of adjectives

positive degree comparative degree super lative degree

positive degree -it is the objective in simple form it is used to denote the mere existence of some quality ,it is used when no comparison is made example : Meenal's litchi is sweet.

The comparative degree- an adjective denotes a higher degree of quality than the positive, it is used when two things are compared . example : Meenal litchi is sweeter than Neha.

Superlative degree- the superlative degree denotes the highest degree of quality ,that is used when more than two things are compared Veena's litchi is sweetest of all.

Superlative is used then there is no idea of comparison .

Example :

- Rama's mango is <u>sweeter</u> than Aman.
- Govinda's mango is <u>sweetest</u> of all.
- Mohan is <u>stronger</u> than Sohan .
- Aman is the <u>strongest</u> boy of the class.
- Bhagat Singh was a <u>brave</u> freedom
