Introduction

Sentences to be covered:

Basic conversation around the situation

OM: Excuse me, madam. I want to meet the doctor.

(मुझे माफ कीजिये, मैडम। मैं डॉक्टर से मिलना चाहता हूँ)

Receptionist-Lady: Do you have an appointment?

(क्या आपके पास अपॉइंटमेंट (नियोजित भेंट) है?)

OM: No, I do not have an appointment.

(नहीं, मेरे पास अपॉइंटमेंट नहीं है ।)

Receptionist-Lady: I am sorry then. You will first have to fix an

appointment.

(मुझे खेद है। आपको पहले अपॉइंटमेंट लेना होगा।)

OM: Could I get an appointment, for now?

(क्या मुझे अभी के लिए एक अपॉइंटमेंट मिल सकता

है?)



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Receptionist-Lady: I am sorry again, he is busy till 8 in the

evening.

(एक बार फिर से मुझे खेद है, वह शाम 8 बजे तक

व्यस्त है।)

OM: Could I get an appointment, for Saturday?

(क्या मुझे शनिवार का अपॉइंटमेंट मिल सकता है?)

Receptionist-Lady: We are closed on Saturday.

(हम शनिवार को बंद रहते हैं।)

OM: Well, so next Monday?

(ठीक है, तो अगले सोमवार?)

Receptionist-Lady: Yes. That'd be fine. He is totally free on

Monday. Would evening 5:30 suit you, sir?

(हाँ। यह सही रहेगा। वे सोमवार को पूरी तरह से

कार्यम्क्त है । शाम 5:30 सही रहेगा, सर?)

OM: Yes, that's perfect.

(हाँ, वह सही है।)

Receptionist-Lady: I've noted it down. Have a nice day, sir.

(मैंने इसे लिख लिया है। अच्छा दिन हो, सर।)

OM: Nice day to you too and thank you.

(आप के लिए भी अच्छा दिन हो और धन्यवाद।)
