Types of Nouns:

1) Common noun -is the name for a person place or thing in a class or group example- man ,ocean, state, cat

Sentences- Neha's mother is the principal.

I saw the postman

2) Proper noun -proper noun is the noun that identifies specific person ,place thing or idea example- Victor, Atlantic California, fluffy

Sentences- My name is Indu.

My best friend lives in Switzerland

3) Collective noun - collective noun is the word used to represent a group of people ,animals or things examples -a gang of thieves ,a fleet of ships, a band of musicians, a class of students

sentences- I love to see a shoal of fish.

A crew of sailor is going for a voyage.

4) Material noun- material noun is the name of a material or substance out of which things are made.

Example- gold, iron, cotton, silver, plastic

Sentences - copper is a good conductor of electricity.

Calcium is good for bones.

5) Abstract noun - it is the name of noun which refers concepts such as emotion, feeling and idea .it does not refer to physical objects.

Examples- love, fear, anger, desire, creativity.

Sentences - India will defeat Pakistan.

Don't underestimate your strength.
