| <b>Yet (Till now) अबतक</b>          |                                   |
| मैंने अबतक ताजमहल नहीं देखा है      | I have not seen the Tajmahal yet. |
| उसने अबतक घर का काम नहीं किया है    | He has not done Homework yet.     |
| मेरी बहिन ने अबतक खाना नहीं खाया है | My sister has not eaten food yet. |

**Still (अभी भी) - we use still when something is continue from past time.**
