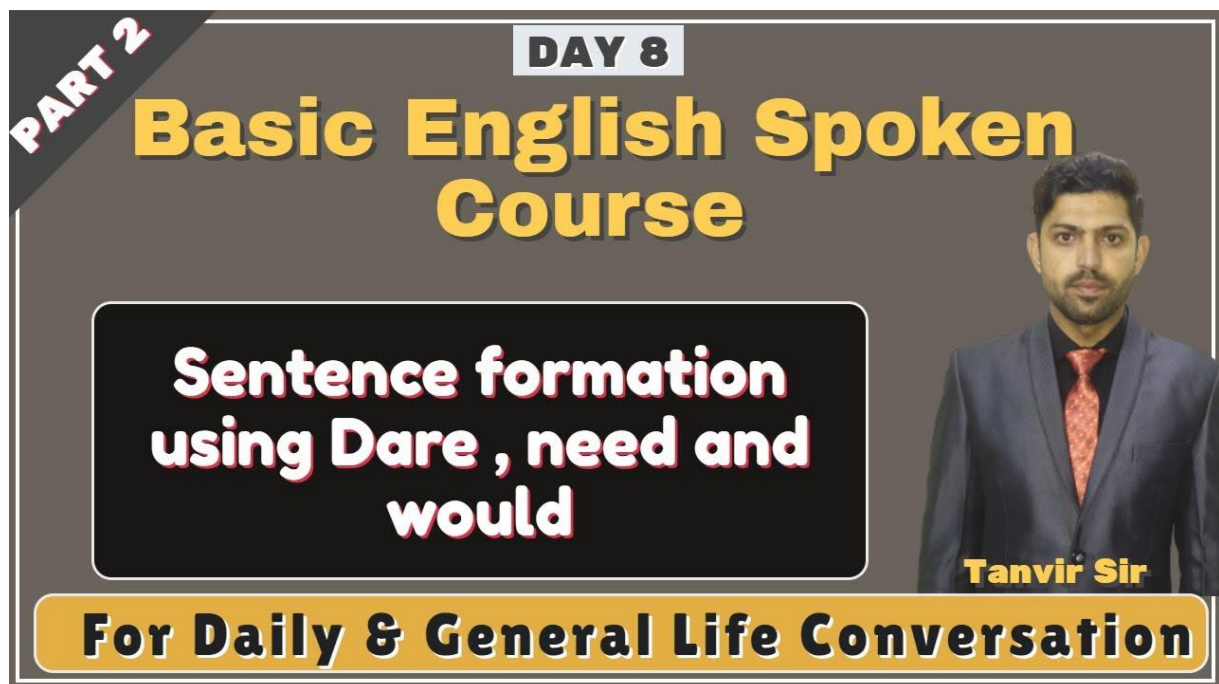

Modal verbs- we use modal verbs to describe advise, order, possibility, capacity, ability, permission etc.

Would - Will का past form होता है **would** जिसका प्रयोग अनेको प्रकार के वाक्य बनाने में किया जाता है। पर इसका कुछ भी फिक्स हिंदी अर्थ नहीं होता है क्योंकि यह एक Modal verb है

would का प्रयोग अन्य कार्यों जैसे इच्छा, विनम्र अनुरोध और प्रश्न, आशा और खेद व्यक्त करने में किया जाता है।

सभी Subjects के साथ would का प्रयोग किया जाता है

Formula: Subject + would + V¹ + Obj.

उदाहरण :

Politeness	Would you go <u>there</u> please?	I would go there मैं वहां जाऊंगा
	क्या आप वहाँ जायेंगे I would like to take coffee. मैं कॉफी लेना चाहूंगा।	I would not go there मैं वहां नहीं जाऊंगा
Conditional	When would she like to come? वह कब आना चाहेगी If you prepared for exam, you would <u>be</u> a successful person. यदि तुम परीक्षा की तैयारी करते तो आज तुम एक सफल व्यक्ति होते	She would like to come on weekend वह वीकेन्ड पर आना चाहेगी

	<p>If you came <u>then</u> I would help you.</p> <p>यदि तुम आते तो मैं तुम्हारी मदद करता</p>	<p>I wish I would be rich.</p> <p>काश मैं आमिर होता</p>
Conditional	<p>If you <u>had</u> given me money I would have helped you.</p> <p>यदि तुम मुझे पैसे दिए होते तो मैं तुम्हारी मदद कर चुका होता</p>	<p>If I were a captain of class I would punish you.</p> <p>यदि मैं क्लास का कैप्टेन होता तो तुम्हें पनिस करता</p>

Dare- We use dare to describe courage.

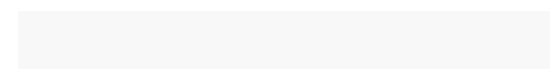
मुख्य क्रिया के रूप Dare का अर्थ साहस करना, हिम्मत करना या चुनौती देना होता है। इसका प्रयोग सभी Tenses में Assertive, Negative और Interrogative के फॉर्म में किया जाता है

सभी Subjects के साथ dare का प्रयोग किया जाता है

Subject + dare + V¹ + Obj

Example:

First Person	How dare you?	He does not dare to go there. वह वहां जाने की हिम्मत नहीं करता
	तुम्हारी हिम्मत कैसे हुई	
Second Person	Dare you Face the robbers? हिम्मत करो तुम लुटेरों का सामना करो	He dare not go there alone. उसमें अकेले वहां जाने का साहस नहीं है
Third Person	I dare not to do this work. मुझ में यह काम करने का साहस नहीं है	They will dare to face the robbers. वे लुटेरों का सामना करने की हिम्मत करेंगे



Need - we use need to describe requirement.

जब हम किसी वाक्य में जरूरत या आवश्यकता का प्रयोग करते हैं

सभी Subjects के साथ Need का प्रयोग किया जाता है

Subject + need + V' + Obj

Person		
First Person	I need to learn English मुझे अंग्रेजी सिखने की जरूरत है	I do not need to learn English मुझे अंग्रेजी सिखने की जरूरत नहीं है
Second Person	Will you need to go to home? क्या तुम्हें घर जाने की जरूरत होगी।	They need to talk उन्हें बात करने की जरूरत है
Third Person	He does not need to go to Bhopal उसे भोपाल जाने की जरूरत नहीं है।	Does she need to write? क्या उस लड़की को लिखने की जरूरत है।
