



There are two numbers singular and plural.

Singular noun- when one thing is spoken the noun is singular.

- 1) Sohan is a doctor.
- 2) Boy is working hard.
- 3) Meena is eating chocolate
- 4) cow gives us milk

Plural - when more than one thing is spoken the noun is plural .

- 1) Boys are intelligent.
- 2) Sohan Mohan and Vikky are doctors.
- 3) Seema and Rita are friends.
- 4) Children are playing.
- 5) Madan has many cows

Rules for forming the plural

RULE 1-Several nouns form their plural by adding S to the singular example

- Book books
- table tables
- COW COWS
- desk desks
- book books
- pen -pens
- shop -shops
- chair- chairs
- month- months
- train -trains
- friend -friends
- teacher -teachers

RULE 2- Noun ending in S, SH, CH, X AND Z take es to make it plural.

#### Eamples-

- box -boxes
- bench -benches
- loss- losses
- bush-bushes
- quiz -quizzes
- Topaz-Topazes

When ch is pronounced as k only s is added to make it plural

- Monarch-monarchs
- Epoch-Epochs

Rule 3 - Nouns ending in the Y preceded by a consonant or qu then change y into ies



#### Example

- city cities
- lady ladies
- soliloquy soliloquies
- Cherry -cherries
- berry berries
- butterfly- butterflies

note - If Y is preceded by vowel then s is added to make it plural.

#### Example

- Boy -boys
- Key-keys
