



We are learning here rules to convert singular to plural noun.

#### Rule - 4:

Nouns ending in f or fe

f or fe Changes into v and es added example

- calf-calves
- life-lives
- knife-knives

#### Rule -5:

Noun ending in ief,ff,oof,rf,eef generally takes only s to make it plural.

- Cliff Cliffs
- proof-proofs
- dwarf-dwarfs
- reef-reefs



NOTE-Some noun takes both the form example .

- staff-staffs/staves
- Wharf- wharfs/wharves
- Scarf-scarfs/scarves

#### Rule 6:

Noun ending in o preceded by a consonant generally takes es in plural

- Hero-Heroes
- Mango mangoes
- volcano volcanoes

but there are few exceptions

- canto Cantos
- piano -pianos
- manifesto -manifestos
- photo -photos
- dynamo -dynamos

Noun-ending in O preceded by a vowel generally takes s in the pural

- Folio- folios
- radio -radios
- bamboo -bamboos
