

Rule-7) Some nouns form their plural by change of vowels
examples

- man -men
- woman -women
- foot -feet
- tooth -teeth
- mouse -mice
- goose -geese
- louse -lice

8)Some nouns form their plural by adding en example

- Child- children
- Ox -oxen



9) some compound nouns are found Plural in the following ways
examples

- son-in-law - son-in-laws tips
- chief minister -chief ministers
- maid servant - maid servants
- girlfriend -girl friends
- boy friend -boy friends

Exceptions:

- men servant -men servants
- man teacher- men teachers
- woman doctor -women doctors
- woman advocate- women advocates

Exceptions:

- man hater- man haters
- man lover- Man lovers
- woman hater- woman haters
- woman lover -woman lovers

READ THE FUNNY POEM AND UNDERSTAND THE SINGULAR AND PLURAL NOUNS

We'll begin with a box, and the plural is boxes;
but the plural of ox became oxen not oxes. One
fowl is a goose, but two are called geese, yet the
plural of moose should never be meese. You may
find a lone mouse or a nest full of mice; yet the

plural of house is houses, not hice. If the plural of man is always called men, why shouldn't the plural of pan be called pen? If I spoke of my foot and show you my feet, and I give you a boot, would a pair be called beet? If one is a tooth and a whole set are teeth, why shouldn't the plural of booth be called beeth? Then one may be that, and three would be those, yet hat in the plural would never be hose, and the plural of cat is cats, not cose. We speak of a brother and also of brethren, but though we say mother, we never say methren. Then the masculine pronouns are he, his and him, but imagine the feminine, she, shis and shim.

Some nouns use the same singular and plural form

- Aircraft- aircraft
- barracks -barracks
- deer- deer
- yellow- yellow
- Moon -Moon
- Salmon -Salmon
- spacecraft -spacecraft
- series -series
- species -species
- deer -deer
- sheep- sheep
