What is a Simple Present Tense?

The simple present is a verb tense with two main uses. We use the simple present tense when an action is happening right now, or when it happens regularly (or unceasingly, which is why it's sometimes called present indefinite). Depending on the person, the simple present tense is formed by using the root form or by adding -s or -es to the end.

Example The sun rises in the east. Does the sun rise in the east? The sun does not rise in the east.





Affirmative Sentences

Subject+ V1(+s/es)+object.

- वह स्कूल जाता है। He goes to school.
- मै क्रिकेट खेलता हूँ। I play cricket.
- वह एक पत्र लिखता है। He writes a letter.

Interrogative Sentences:

Do/Does+Subject+ V1 + Object+?

Does he go to school? Do I play cricket? Does he write a letter?

Negative Sentences:

Subject+ Do/does+not+ V1 + Object.

He does not go to school. I do not play cricket. He does not write a letter.

Interrogative+ Negative Sentence



Do/Does+Subject+not+ V' + Object+?

Does he not go to school? Do I not play cricket? Does he not write a letter?

Translate and change into interrogative and negative form:

Answers

You drink milk daily. You don't drink milk daily. Do you drink milk daily? Do you not drink milk daily?

Mohan runs daily. Mohan doesn't run daily. Does Mohan roam daily? Does Mohan not roam daily?

We take a bath daily. We don't take a bath daily



We know swimming. We don't know swimming. Do we know swimming? Do we not know swimming?
