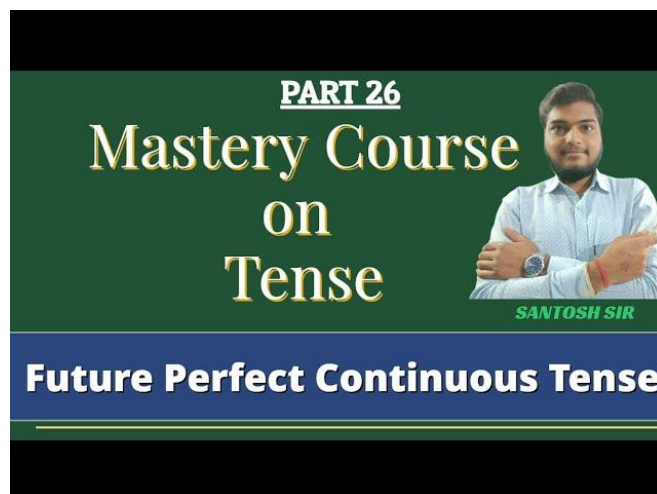

Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Hindi to English)

Recognition (पहचान) :

Future Perfect Continuous Tense के हिन्दी वाक्यों के अन्त में रहा होगा, रही होगी, रहे होंगे, रहा हूँगा आदि शब्द आते हैं | Future Perfect Continuous Tense के वाक्यों में समय दिया रहता है जबकि Future Continuous Tense के वाक्यों में समय नहीं दिया होता है |

Affirmative Sentences

- 1- पिताजी दस मिनट से अखबार पढ़ रहे होंगे |
- 2- माताजी आधा घन्टे से खाना बना रही होंगी |
- 3- लड़के एक घन्टे से मैदान में क्रिकेट खेल रहे होंगे |
- 4- मुख्य मंत्री जी एक घन्टे से स्टेज पर भाषण दे रहे होंगे |
- 5- वह दो घन्टे से संगीत सुन रहा होगा |
- 6- राधा दस बजे से उसका इन्तज़ार कर रही होगी |
- 7- वे एक साल से निबन्ध लिख रहे होंगे |

8- हम छः महीने से उसका कंप्यूटर इस्तेमाल कर रहे होंगे ।

Subject + will/shall have been + verb(1st form)ing + object + time-reference

इसे हम इस तरह भी लिख सकते हैं ।

Subject + auxiliary verb + main verb + object + time-reference

Translation :

- 1- The father will have been reading the newspaper for ten minutes.
- 2- The mother will have been cooking the food for half an hour.
- 3- The boys will have been playing cricket in the ground for an hour.
- 4- The chief minister will have been delivering speech on the stage for an hour.
- 5- He will have been listening to music for two hours.

6- Radha will have been waiting for him since 10 o'clock.

7- They will have been writing essay for one year.

8- We shall have been using her computer for six months.

9- Radha will have been singing a sweet song since 10 o'clock.

10- I shall have been starting my business since May.

Future Perfect Continuous Tense Hindi to English

Negative Sentences

1- सितारे छः बजे से आकाश में नहीं चमक रहे होंगे ।

2- बच्चे सुबह से शोर नहीं मचा रहे होंगे ।

3- वह छः महीने से फेक्ट्री में कार्य नहीं कर रहा होगा ।

Subject + will/shall + not + have been + verb(1st form)ing + object + time-reference

1- The stars will not have been shining in the sky since 6 o'clock.

2- The children will not have been making a noise since morning.

3- He will not have been working in the factory for six months.

4- He will not have been running his business since April.

5- We shall not have been going to school since Monday.

6- We shall not have been washing the clothes since 1 o'clock.

7- We shall not have been listening to music for many days.

8- The gardener will not have been watering to the plants since 10 o'clock.

9- The children will not have been weeping in the room since morning.

10- The teacher will not have been teaching the students for two days.

Formula (जब वाक्य के बीच में question हो)

*Question Word + will/shall + subject + have been + verb(ing form) + object +
since/for + time reference*
