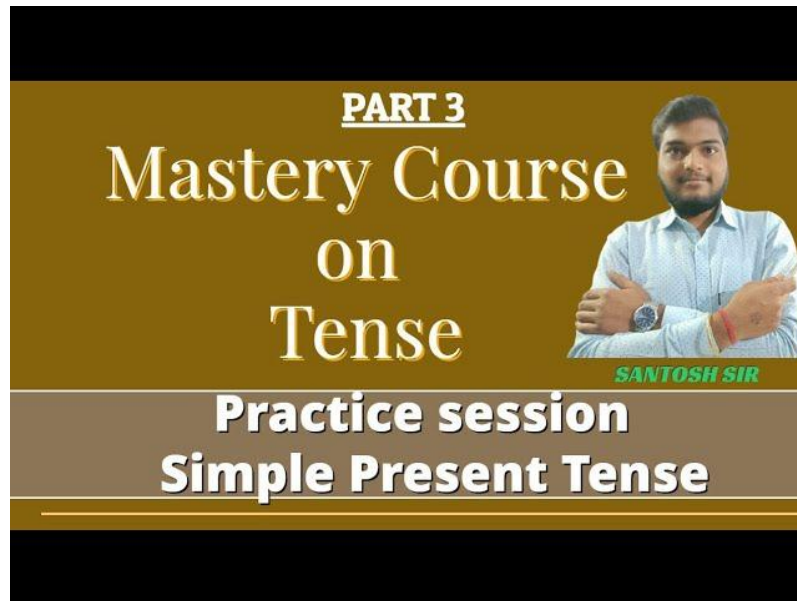

Practice Session Simple Present Tense

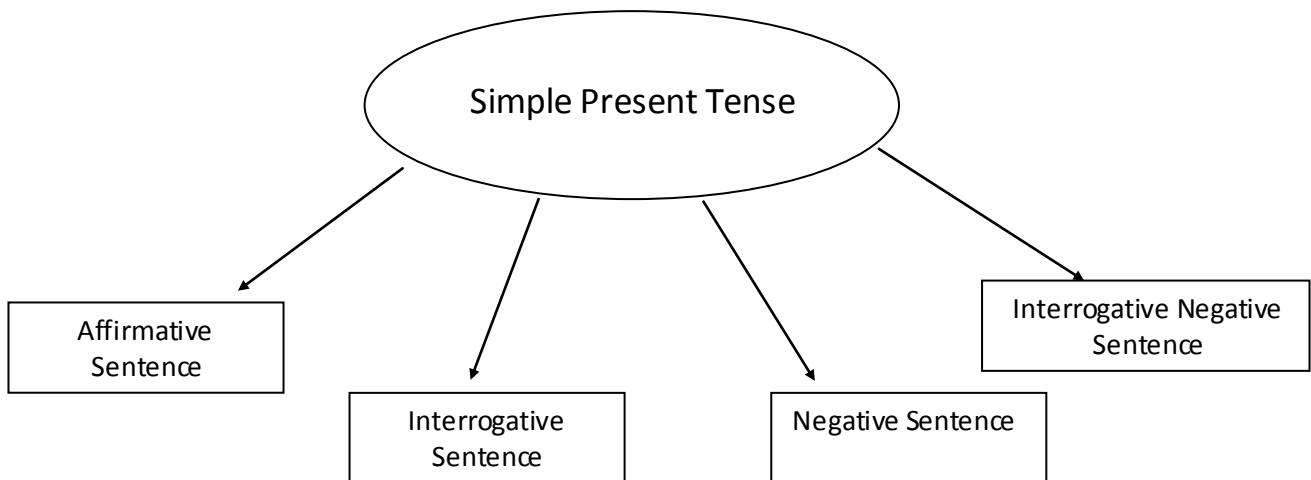
The simple present is a verb tense with two main uses. We use the simple present tense when an action is happening right now, or when it happens regularly (or unceasingly, which is why it's sometimes called present indefinite). Depending on the person, the simple present tense is formed by using the root form or by adding -s or -es to the end.

Example

The sun rises in the east.

Does the sun rise in the east?

The sun does not rise in the east.



Affirmative Sentences

Subject+ V1(+s/es)+object.

If a subject is singular then inly uses s/es with a verb

For example He/she/it or with someones's name you will use s/es with a verb

With Plural subject like I/we/you/They or any other form of plural subject we omit the use of s/es with a verb.

Examples:

- वह स्कूल जाता है। He goes to school.
- मैं क्रिकेट खेलता हूँ। I play cricket.
- वह एक पत्र लिखता है। He writes a letter.
- हम रोज नहाते हैं। We bath daily.

Interrogative Sentences:

Do/Does+Subject+ V1
+ Object+?

Does he go to school?

Do I play cricket?

Does he write a letter?

Negative Sentences:

Subject+ Do/does+not+ V1
+ Object.



He does not go to school.
I do not play cricket.
He does not write a letter.

Interrogative+ Negative Sentence

Do/Does+Subject+not+ V1
+ Object+?

Does he not go to school?
Do I not play cricket?
Does he not write a letter?

2. Sohan will come tomorrow.

Answers

He comes next week.
Sohan comes the next day.
