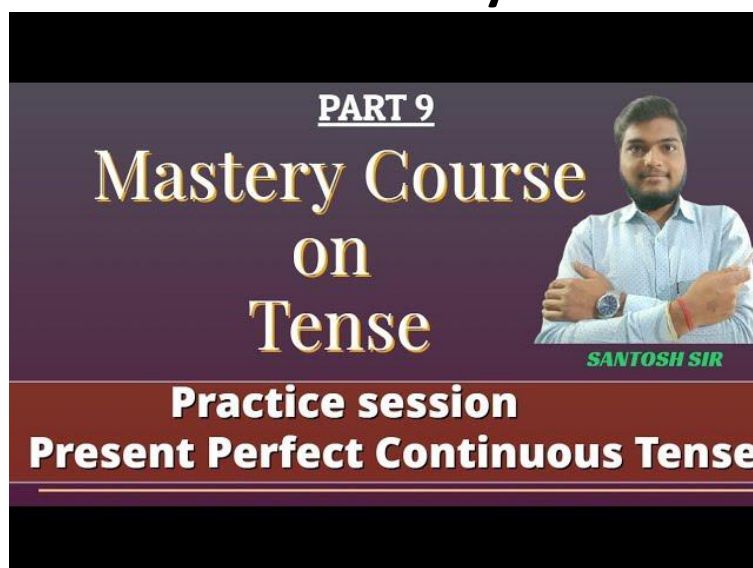

Present Perfect Continuous Affirmative Sentences In Hindi (सकारात्मक वाक्य)
